Admission Policies and Procedures

Selma University is a four-year institution accredited by ABHE (Association for Biblical Higher Education). We have an open door policy for enrollment. Each applicant must present satisfactory credentials. The final decision for admittance is based on the following:

1. A complete admission application on file that is signed and dated.
2. An official copy of immunization records, a copy of recent TB Skin Test Results and a complete physical examination (Less than two years old).
3. Submit official transcripts, and/or official GED from all high schools, colleges, universities and technical programs to the Office of Admissions.
4. A one page essay explaining why you feel that you will be a successful asset here at Selma University.
